This leaves humane organizations in a difficult position, unable to offer these animals the same opportunities for adoption as other domestic pets.

By supporting Petition 2025-003, you would be advocating for a compassionate and practical solution—one that allows shelters, rescues, and responsible pet owners to properly care for, place, and protect domestic ferrets.
